

### **Short Description**

The Sustainable Economy Summit is a two-day C-level summit focused on the socio-ecological transformation of the economy. On April 21–22, 2026, the event will bring leading decision-makers from business and politics together in Berlin to discuss and advance concrete solutions for a sustainable future. The summit highlights practical innovations and business models that align economic success with planetary boundaries and social responsibility.

### **Ziel und Nutzen der Veranstaltung**

The Sustainable Economy Summit aims to create a platform for dialogue, networking, and collaboration. Companies with proven sustainability expertise meet political decision-makers. With the publication of the Sustainable Economy Barometer—a representative Civey study conducted among decision-makers within the German economy—reliable insights into the status of the sustainable economic transformation are systematically analyzed and presented during the event.

### **The event particularly supports:**

- the transfer of best practices into economic applications
- direct dialogue between business and politics
- the development of scalable sustainable business models
- the acceleration of the socio-ecological transformation

### **Event Format**

The summit takes place as an in-person and hybrid event in Berlin. The program includes keynotes, panels, workshops, and networking formats.

- Agriculture

- Sustainable construction

These topics are addressed across sectors to promote systemic solutions.

### **Target Groups**

The event is primarily aimed at:

- Executive board members and managing directors
- Decision-makers from corporations, SMEs, and start-ups
- Representatives from politics

This means the summit addresses actors with high implementation and decision-making competence.

### **Contribution to Sustainable Development**

The Sustainable Economy Summit sees itself not only as a discourse platform but also as part of the solution. The event is planned and implemented according to the principle “Avoid – Reduce – Compensate.”

Key sustainability approaches include:

- resource-efficient event planning
- promotion of climate-friendly mobility for participants
- sustainable catering and material use
- hybrid participation options to reduce travel emissions
