LEIPA Georg Leinfelder issues the following declaration of compliance for above-mentioned trade product.

Food Contact

The trade product is in compliance with the relevant requirements of the following regulations:

- Regulation (EC) no. 1935/2004 of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and repealing Directives 80/590/EEC and 89/109/EEC, Official Journal of the European Union L 338/4 of 13 November 2004, lastly modified by article 5 of the Regulation (EU) 2019/1381 of 20 June 2019, Official Journal of the European Union L 231/1 of 6 September 2019, article 3, 1. (a) and (b),
- *German Lebensmittel-, Bedarfsgegenstände und Futtermittelgesetzbuch LFGB (Foodstuffs, Consumer Goods and Animal Feed Code) in the version of the notification of 15 September 2021 (BGBl. p. 4253), last amendment by article 7 of the law of 27 September 2021, §§ 30 and 31*
- German BfR XXXVI. Recommendation on paper and board for food contact, recasted by 62nd Announcement, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 14 (1971) 83, last amended by 225th Announcement, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 65 (2022) 525-526, as of 1 April 2022

The trade product may be used safely for food packaging.

It may stand in direct contact with foodstuffs which are peeled, shelled or washed before consumption and may also be used for secondary packaging. For dry, non-fatty foodstuffs with large surfaces, the migration of volatile and hydrophobic substances via the gas phase has to be considered particularly. This could be ensured by the use of an appropriate intermediate packaging.

Product safety management

For the manufacturing of the trade product, LEIPA Georg Leinfelder GmbH, site Schrobenhausen, has implemented product safety measures based on European GMP regulation:

- Risk assessment for production processes on the basis of HACCP concept
- Hygiene rules for the production area
- Hygiene training for production employees
- Pest Control by a certified external service provider
- Protocols for glass breakages within the production area

Toy safety

The trade product is in compliance with:

- DIN EN 71, part 3 "Safety of Toys, Migration of Certain Elements", state of June 2021, regarding the migration of certain elements
- DIN EN 71, part 9 "Safety of Toys, Organic chemical compounds – Requirements", state of September 2007, concerning the migration of prohibited colorants and primary aromatic amines.

Origin of wood – Forest sustainability

For the production of the trade product, only recycled raw fibers are used. The fraction of recycled fibers is 100 %.

LEIPA Georg Leinfelder GmbH fully complies with European Regulation 995/2010/EC (timber regulation) as a trader. As such, LEIPA does not operate a due diligence system, but fulfills all applicable requirements in regard of traceability of wood products.

Heavy metals and RoHS-Directive

The trade product is in compliance with:

- Directive (EC) 94/62/EC on packaging and packaging waste from 20 December 1994, Official Journal of the EU L L 365/10 of 31 December 1994, last amended by the Directive (EC) 2018/852 from 30 May 2018, Official Journal of the EU L 150/141 of 14 June 2018
- Model Toxics Legislation as developed by the Source Reduction Council of CONEG of 14 December 1989, last modification of December 2008

in regard to it's heavy metal content.

The sum of concentration levels of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and chromium (Cr incl. Cr (VI)) is less than 100 ppm.

REACH-Regulation and material safety data sheets

We have not received any notification from our suppliers that any used materials contain substances of very high concern (SVHC) according to article 33 of Regulation 1907/2006/EC. We further confirm that we do not add substances of very high concern intentionally within our production process.

Our products are not subject of article no. 31 of regulation 1907/2006/EC. Thus we are not obliged to issue safety data sheets.

Other substances

The following substances are no constitutional part of the trade product and are not added intentionally within the production process:

- Titanium Dioxide (TiO₂)
 - Biocides
 - Substances of vegetal/animal origin in regard to the release of GMO
 - Substances of animal origin in regard to BSE/TSE
 - Chlorine
- The trade product is not bleached and produced totally chlorine free (TCF).

Technical information on climatic environment

Paper and board is constantly trying to achieve an equilibrium with ambient air in terms of moisture content. We advise our customers to remove the packaging shortly before processing and after the climatic adjustment to ambient production condition is completed.

The optimal processing environment is 18 – 20 °C at 50 – 56 % relative humidity.
