For SPECTRUM, we turned to Note Design Studio to develop a new expression of natural colours. Drawing on their insights into colour, they grouped tonalities together according to warm and cold hues, adding subtle gradations of shades in between that can easily partner with more vivid hues. Resulting in a nuanced, harmonious palette that spans the entire colour spectrum.
